Student Expectations:

- Maintain a C or Better in All Courses
 A.Tutoring: Attendance is Expected if Grades Fall Below a C-

- 3. Participate in Extra Curricular MHSA Activities

<u>Medical and Health Services Academy Scheduling</u>: In the event there is conflict in course selection for an upcoming academic year, all MHSA classes will take priority over other courses.

<u>Grades</u>: Students are expected to maintain a C or better in ALL courses. If a student's grade falls below a C in any course, the student is expected to attend Tutoring until the grade improves to a C or better at the next grading period.

<u>Dress Code</u>: To promote unity, excellence, and pride, students will be required to wear scrub tops and/or MHSA shirts.

Projects: Students are expected to complete curricular and co-curricular projects during each academic year. Projects will increase in depth and difficultly as students advance through MHSA.

Guest Speakers: Guest speakers will introduce aspects of the medical and health services.

Extra-Curricular Activities: Extra-curricular activities may be scheduled after school and on weekends. Notification will be made as soon as possible for events/activities that go beyond regular school hours.
