# Census Countdown: 9 weeks to Census Day (April 1, 2020)

This week's update provides additional information to support your work towards achieving the project's purpose which is to educate, motivate, and activate students, parents, and families to engage in the 2020 Census.

These updates are written with district coordinators in mind, but you can certainly select components to share with others in your district as you deem appropriate.

# <u>Census Webinar – Monday Jan. 27</u>

The next Census webinar will be held this afternoon, Monday, January 27 at 1:00 via Zoom (https://brandman.zoom.us/my/cwoozoomroom). At that webinar we will look at the timeline for Census activities and review a sample of the census questionnaire so that you can see exactly what questions are asked on the census and how it is organized. There will also be opportunities for questions and for districts/programs to share plans for educating students, parents and families about the 2020 Census. At this webinar we will also review the documents for reporting your district activities. A link to the recording of the meeting will be sent out after the meeting (either later that day or on Tuesday morning).

## **Guidance on using Promotional Items:**

The state Census office has provided the following guidance to address questions regarding promotional items.

- 1) Promotional items should support activities in the MOU.
- 2) Cost for each promotional item shall not exceed five dollars.
- 3) Cost for food used as a promotional item shall not exceed five dollars per person.
- 4) CA Census logo shall be used on the promotional items, when possible.

# **Interactive Hard To Count Populations Map:**

The state Census office has developed an interactive map with a wealth of information by census tract and block. At the Jan. 27 webinar a brief overview will be provided. Using the map allows users to identify specific neighborhoods to target for outreach based on the hard to count index.
