Overview of the Citizens' Oversight Committees

In June 2006, the voters of the State of California authorized an amendment to the California Constitution (Proposition 39) lowering the voter approval requirement from 2/3rds to 55% for school districts that provide voters a specific list of projects, a committee of appointed citizens to oversee the expenditure of funds and an annual performance audit and financial audit of the bond funds and bond projects. Proposition 39 provides that the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall have at least seven (7) members who shall serve up to two (2) terms of two (2) years each. Initially, three (3) members will be appointed to a one-year term and four (4) members will be appointed to a two-year term. All appointees, regardless of the original term of appointment, are limited to a third term, not to exceed six years.

Purpose

Because the District elected to pursue a bond election under the provisions of Proposition 39, State law requires the District to establish a Citizens' Oversight Committee appointed by the District's Governing Board. The Committee's purpose is to:

- Actively monitor all projects and expenditures, approved by the voters.
- Provide proper oversight and accountability to ensure that the Measure B funds are being used as intended.
- Report to members of the community on the progress of the Measure B projects.

Duties

Duties of the Committee will include:

- Ensuring that the Bond funds are spent only on projects listed in the Bond Project List and that no funds are used for salaries or general operating expenses.
- Monitor the progress of each Bond project.
- Receive and review copies of the annual performance and financial audits of Bond projects, as required by California State law (Proposition 39).
- Providing information to the public on the progress of the Bond projects and the expenditures of the Bond funds.
