Dear Tracy Unified School District Families and Community Members,

Recently the Trump administration announced that it will be rescinding the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program and will be phasing it out over the next number of months, leaving the fates of Dreamers in the hands of Congress.

I understand that many in our community may be uncertain and anxious due to this recent announced change in the DACA.

On February 15, 2017, the Tracy Unified School District Board of Trustees adopted Resolution No. 16-16 (Commitment to Education of All Children). The resolution reaffirms that Tracy Unified School District embraces the diversity of our students and families and the rich language and cultural assets they bring to the District, and strongly supports and encourages the participation of all parents and families in our schools.

Resolution No. 16-16 also reaffirms that all students have the right to attend Tracy Unified schools regardless of the immigration status of the child or of the child's family members. Resolution No. 16-16 also declares that every District site is a safe place for all students and their families.

The Tracy Unified School District will continue to comply with all Federal and State Laws governing the privacy of student records including the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

We are committed to the safety and welfare of all of our students and will do everything we can to ensure their safety and success. Thank you for all of your support.
